Thank you for choosing SoliTek panels. Please read this guide in it's entirely before the unpacking the pallets. Failure of follow instructions in this guide may damage system components, endanger personnel, damage property, or invalidate the panel warranty.

The purpose of this document is to provide minimum requirements and recommendations for safe and successful unpacking of SoliTek PV modules.



CAUTION:

Always adhere to the following handling precautions of the pallets:

- Modules itself are fragile. Handle the pallet as well as PV module with care
- **DO NOT** stack more than 2 pallets on top of one another
- Prevent pallets from the rain or humidity as it may damage packaging
- Always maintain pallets in a flat position. Uneven ground may cause collapse of the pallet and module breakage
- **DO NOT** cut plastic straps until installation commences
- Transport pallets with a fork lift having enough weightlifting capacity
- Wear gloves while unpacking and carrying the modules


Handling of PV modules

SoliTek PV modules must be transported in the supplied packaging only and kept in the packaging until they are ready to be installed. Protect pallets against movement and exposure to damage during transportation. Secure pallets from falling over. Do not exceed the maximum height of pallets to be stacked by two floors. Store pallets in a cool and dry location until the PV modules are ready to be unpackaged. Prevent pallet from the rain or humidity as it might spoil the packaging.

SoliTek PV modules are heavy, and should be handled with care. Never use the junction box or cables as a grip. Do not exert mechanical stress on the cables. Never step on PV modules or drop or place heavy objects on them. Be careful when placing PV modules on hard surfaces, and secure them from falling. Broken glass can result in personal injury. PV modules with broken glass cannot be repaired and must not be used. Broken or damaged PV modules must be handled carefully and disposed of properly.

UNPACKAGING


STEP 1

Cut plastic straps carefully




STEP 2

Take off top cover by lifting it up




STEP 3

Remove carton side by lifting it up



STEP 4

Carry modules together with plastic corners to the final mounting place for corners protection. Take off plastic corners only when module is in its final installation place



STEP 5

Collect plastic corners into one of the pallets from the modules. We will collect plastic corners from You starting from 500 sets
